WEDNESDAY	
*	Genesis 1:26 - And God said, Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of heaven and over the cattle and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth.
	Hebrews 9:14 - How much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God?
	Colossians 2:9 - For in Him [Christ] dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily,
	John 15:26 - But when the Comforter comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of reality, who proceeds from the Father, He will testify concerning Me
	Isaiah 9:6 - For a child is born to us, / A Son is given to us; / And the government / Is upon His shoulder; / And His name will be called / Wonderful Counselor, / Mighty God, / Eternal Father, / Prince of Peace.
	Philippians 2:9 - Therefore also God highly exalted Him and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name
	John 20:28 - Thomas answered and said to Him, My Lord and my God!
	John 4:24 - God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truthfulness.
	1 Corinthians 15:45b - ...the last Adam became a life-giving Spirit.
	John 1:1 - In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
THURSDAY	
*	Matthew 28:19 - Go therefore and disciple all the nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
	Ephesians 2:17-18 - And coming, He announced peace as the gospel to you who were far off, and peace to those who were near, For through Him we both have access in one Spirit unto the Father.
	Matthew 4:4 - But He answered and said, “It is written, ‘Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that proceeds out through the mouth of God.’”
	1 Timothy 2:5 - For there is one God and one Mediator of God and men, the man Christ Jesus,
	John 1:3 - All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him not one thing came into being which has come into being.
	John 11:35 - Jesus wept
	Romans 8:9-11 - But you are not in the flesh, but in the spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Yet if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not of Him. But if Christ is in you, though the body is dead because of sin, the spirit is life because of righteousness. And if the Spirit of the One who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who indwells you.
	John 6:57 - As the living Father has sent Me and I live because of the Father, so he who eats Me, he also shall live because of Me.

*	Hebrews 12:2 - Looking away unto Jesus, the Author and Perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down on the right hand of the throne of God.
	Romans 6:6 - Knowing this, that our old man has been crucified with Him in order that the body of sin might be annulled, that we should no longer serve sin as slaves
	Revelation 1:18 - And the living One; and I became dead, and behold, I am living forever and ever; and I have the keys of death and of Hades
	Romans 1:14 - Who was designated the Son of God in power according to the Spirit of holiness out of the resurrection of the dead, Jesus Christ our Lord
	1 Peter 1:3 - Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has regenerated us unto a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead
	John 12:24 - Truly, truly, I say to you, Unless the grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it abides alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit
	John 1:29 - The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!
	1 John 1:9 - If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
	Romans 4:25 - Who was delivered for our offenses and was raised for our justification
	Colossians 2:14 - Wiping out the handwriting in ordinances, which was against us, which was contrary to us; and He has taken it out of the way, nailing it to the cross
SATURDAY	
*	2 Corinthians 13:14 - The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.
	John 17:21 - That they all may be one; even as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us; that the world may believe that You have sent Me.
	John 15:5 - I am the vine; you are the branches. He who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit; for apart from Me you can do nothing.
	Mark 16:18 - So then the Lord Jesus, after speaking to them, was taken up into heaven and sat at the right hand of God.
	Revelation 22:20 - He who testifies these things says, Yes, I come quickly. Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!
	2 Peter 1:4 - Through which He has granted to us precious and exceedingly great promises that through these you might become partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption which is in the world by lust
	Ephesians 4:8 - Therefore the Scripture says, "Having ascended to the height, He led captive those taken captive and gave gifts to men."
	Matthew 24:36 - But concerning that day and hour, no one knows, not even the angels of the heavens nor the Son, but the Father only.
